

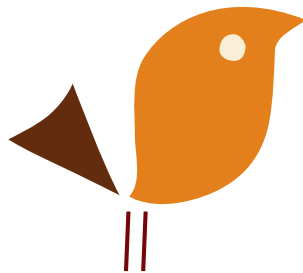

about crafter-school 2010/11



The Crafter-School program is open to students grades 2-6 attending Roscoe Village campuses or schools with a Roscoe Street bus-stop.

Schedule & Calendar

- Crafter-School hours are Monday-Friday, 145 pm -6 pm, with the exception of school holidays.
- A walking escort to the workshop is provided to local students each day at school dismissal or bus drop-off time.
- The following agenda is approximate and may be adjusted to accommodate the needs of the participants:
 - Homework & Reading (snack will be provided during this time)
 - Craft Projects and/or Outdoor Play (weather permitting)
 - Open Play or Reading (reading, games)
- Crafter-Schoolers may be **offered open spots in art and craft classes** scheduled during afternoon hours.
- Crafter-School is closed on holiday breaks, though other camps and workshops may be scheduled during school closure-days or holidays. Crafter-School participants receive first-choice registration.

Philosophy

Plain old good manners are encouraged at the workshop. We believe that a "generous habit of thought and of action carries with it an incalculable influence", and in the capabilities of each participant to do their best and to encourage positive support of one another. We choose "do's" over "don't's". Constructive behavior is modeled, and participants are given opportunities to develop their own conflict-resolution and leadership skills. Creatively, we value the process of creativity over the product. Materials are explored and skills are demonstrated, and throughout an opportunity to succeed within one's capabilities is created. Wishcraft provides a clean and healthy environment.

Policy

Our policies are intended to keep fees as low as possible while maintaining a small and nurturing program.

- Session fees are based on a weekly fee of \$75. Fees and forms are payable 2 weeks before the start of the session. Unpaid registration fees or missing forms may forfeit the participant's place in the program. Payment arrangements may be possible but cannot be guaranteed.
- A non-refundable deposit (applicable toward the next session fee) is due 4 weeks prior to the next session. The deposit for the Fall session is equal to 4-week's fees (\$300) and 1-week's fee for all other sessions (\$75).
- 10% of the registration fee is discounted for the first sibling (i.e. 100% fee for 1st participant, 90% fee for the 2nd.)
- Pick-up time is by 6pm. The late fee is \$1/minute per participant and will be charged on a weekly basis using the credit card on file. Two late pick-ups of no more than 5 minutes each are granted per session before this late fee is assessed.
- Refunds for cancellation of participation in a session (future or current) will be provided if a) cancellation notice is received 4-weeks prior to the cancellation date and/or b)the spot can be immediately filled with someone on the waiting list. Refunds reflect deduction of a 20% administrative fee.

Other Things to Know

- Students may bring their own reading material or other quiet activities. (Participants may bring their own craft projects or small games for Open Time.)
- Students may bring age-appropriate music to share on the workshop's ipod dock.
- An area will be provided for each participant to hold small necessities such as lip balm, lotion, personal-care items, etc.
- The snacks provided by the workshop are usually organic or natural and always peanut-free. Participant's are welcome to bring their own snack if they prefer.
- A reusable water glass will be provided for each participant, and a drinking-water dispenser is located at the workshop.
- Participants will only be released to individuals listed on the registration form. A signature on the sign-out form as well as ID will be required.
- Inhalers and other medicines must be accompanied by a doctor's note.
- Older students may be released to walk home and/or to the workshop with a parent's written approval *and* in-person parent/Wishcraft conversation.

Participant Commitment (parents, please discuss the following with your child, if necessary)

I will be a positive influence on myself and other participants in the crafter-school program. I will do my best and ask for help when I need it. I will respect the workshop and the people and things in it, and expect that all other participants will do the same for me. I will be prepared to participate each day and will be open to trying new things. I will be polite to all participants and support each other's creative exploration. I understand that if I do these things I am welcome to participate in the program.

Parent Commitment

I will support my child's participation in the program by helping them to understand what is expected of them. I will pick-up my child on time each day and will notify Wishcraft of any planned or unplanned absence at least 2 hours in advance of school dismissal time by telephone call or email. I will support the workshop's protection of my child's safety by cooperating with policies, and will advise the workshop immediately upon any change in emergency contact information. As I would with school, I will only send my healthy child to the program. I understand the program's schedule, calendar and registration/fee policies and will comply accordingly. I will bring any concern to the attention of Wishcraft so that it may be resolved promptly and constructively.
